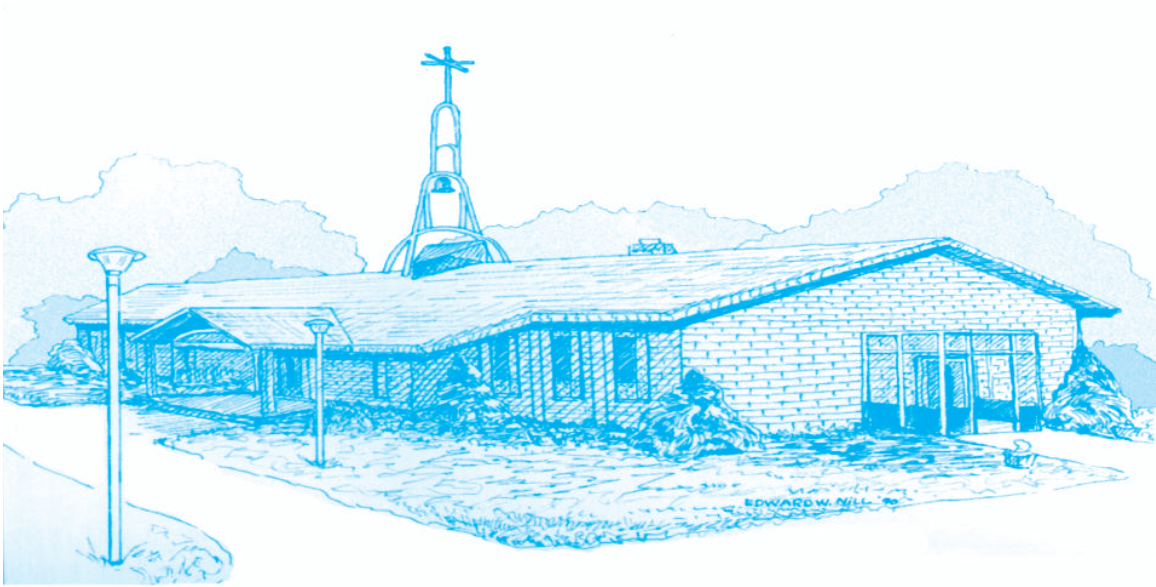

Do you have a special craft you would like to donate to be sold at the Ladies Guild Harvest Bazaar which will be held the first Saturday in November? Look for upcoming information.

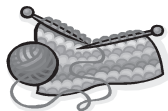
